GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION ADVANCED LEVEL

- A level the 'gold standard' of Cambridge qualifications.
- accepted as an entry qualification by universities of the European Union and elsewhere around the world.
- highly specialized: a student will normally take 3 subjects.



Cambridge AS & A Level -International Curriculum

- Students develop deep subject knowledge, conceptual understanding and higher order thinking skills.
- They learn the skills needed for life and to achieve at school, university and work
- Flexibility of study -students can choose from 55 subjects.
- Over 500 000 entries a year from 134 countries.
- Exams taken at the end of the course -students develop a deeper understanding of subjects.
- Choice of three assessment options.
- Each subject receives a separate grade.

Grades are from A* to E, with A* being the highest.

Exams in November and June with flexibility of timing.
